Day 3, 21 July

8.00h-15.00h. (**12.00h.** Lunch break) Hands-on animal model (rabbit): laparoscopic biopsies, laparoscopic cholecystectomy, laparoscopic ovariectomy, laparoscopic nephrectomy.
21.00h. Group dinner

Day 4, 22 July

8.00h-15.00h. (**12.00h.** Lunch break) Hands-on animal model (sheep): lung biopsies, biopsy of mediastinal lymph node, dissection and ligation of intercostal vessels and pericardiectomy.

Terms and conditions for custom training stays in the Minimally Invasive Surgery Centre "Jesús Usón" (JUMISC)

1. Specifications on budgets:

- Unless otherwise indicated, the activities of training on demand are budgeted for students to work in pairs. On the assumption that the number of attendants is odd, the registration fee of the attendant who will perform the activity without partner will be the price of the complete surgical station.
- If the agenda of the formative activity included a schedule that was outside the period of duration of the normal working hours of JUMISC (09:00 to 19:00 hours from Monday to Friday) or Saturday morning, hours of excess will have an additional cost.

2. Cancellation policy:

Cancellation by the organization:

- JUMISC reserves the right to cancel an activity if the minimum number of inscriptions is not reached, as well as to change the dates of implementation if necessary for reasons beyond the control of the organisers.
- In case of cancellation of the activity, the JUMISC will return the full registration fee, but will not be responsible for any cost of the assistance as the purchase of tickets or reservations of accommodation.

Cancellation by the attendant:

- If the attendant wants to cancel the registration should be done at least FIFTEEN DAYS before the beginning of the activity. In the case of cancelling the activity with less than fifteen days and up to 7 days before, the attendant will be refunded the amount, with the exception of 10%, which will be retained for administrative expenses. In the case that the attendant communicates with less than SEVEN DAYS in advance, 75% of the initially budgeted will be retained.
- When the promoter of the training activity request the accreditation of the activity, the promoter shall send the CV of lecturers with a minimum of 75 days before the beginning of the activity. In addition, the management costs arising from the request will be passed on in the final budget of the activity.



3. When the attendant considers that any circumstance of his state of health (e.g., pregnancy) may affect the development of the training activity scheduled (inhalation anaesthesia, ionizing radiation, etc.), it must be communicated as soon as possible to the JUMISC. In these cases, the JUMISC does not guarantee the availability of spaces isolated or alternatives to the planned development of this activity.
